**School Bus Safety Rules**

1. The most important element of school bus transportation is the safety of students. These rules are aimed at the safety and security of students. In order to achieve its aim the teachers on bus duty must have the co-operation of all student riders.

2. Conduct on the school bus shall be of the same high standard as expected in the school building and classroom. All school rules apply while students are on the bus. Students shall be courteous to fellow riders and their bus driver. Such acts as fighting, pushing, obscene talk or gestures will not be tolerated and will be cause for disciplinary action.

**3. Rules for getting on the bus safely:**

a. Be at the stop 5 minutes prior to your scheduled pickup time. Never run to or from the bus. In order to maintain a strict time schedule, **drivers cannot wait for students.**

b) Wait at the designated stop in a safe place well away from the side of the bus. Remember the danger zone around the bus. **The danger zone is anywhere close enough to the bus to touch it. The bus driver cannot see you when you are in the danger zone.**

c) If you cross the street to get on the bus: when the bus comes, wait until it has come to a complete stop. Walk, don't run.

d) In the afternoon the buses depart from school in two batches. All students in the First Batch must board the bus within 10 minutes of the school getting over. The buses in the first batch will leave at 1.45 p.m.

e) The second batch will depart by 1.55-2.00 p.m. students of this batch must report at the Assembly Point for marking of the attendance. As and when announcements are made to board the bus, all students must form a queue. The teacher in-charge will lead the queue, wait at the door of the bus till the last student gets into the bus.

f) The drivers will not wait for the students who do not report on time. No student commuting by bus will leave the school premises until the announcement is made regarding arrival of the bus.
